SAFETY IMPROVEMENTS

The Alaska Department of Transportation, in partnership with HC Contractors, is working to construct safety improvements on Phillips Field Road from Jack Lindsey Lane to Driveway Street. This will include shoulder widening, minor road realignment, building a retaining wall and utility relocations. We will do our best to keep you updated as work progresses and appreciate your patience and cooperation during construction. This project is expected to be complete by October 2018.

Planned Project Details:

- Work is expected to start on May 1, 2018.
- A 90-day ROAD CLOSURE is expected during this time. Please plan to follow DETOUR routes.
