NEW TRAFFIC PATTERN

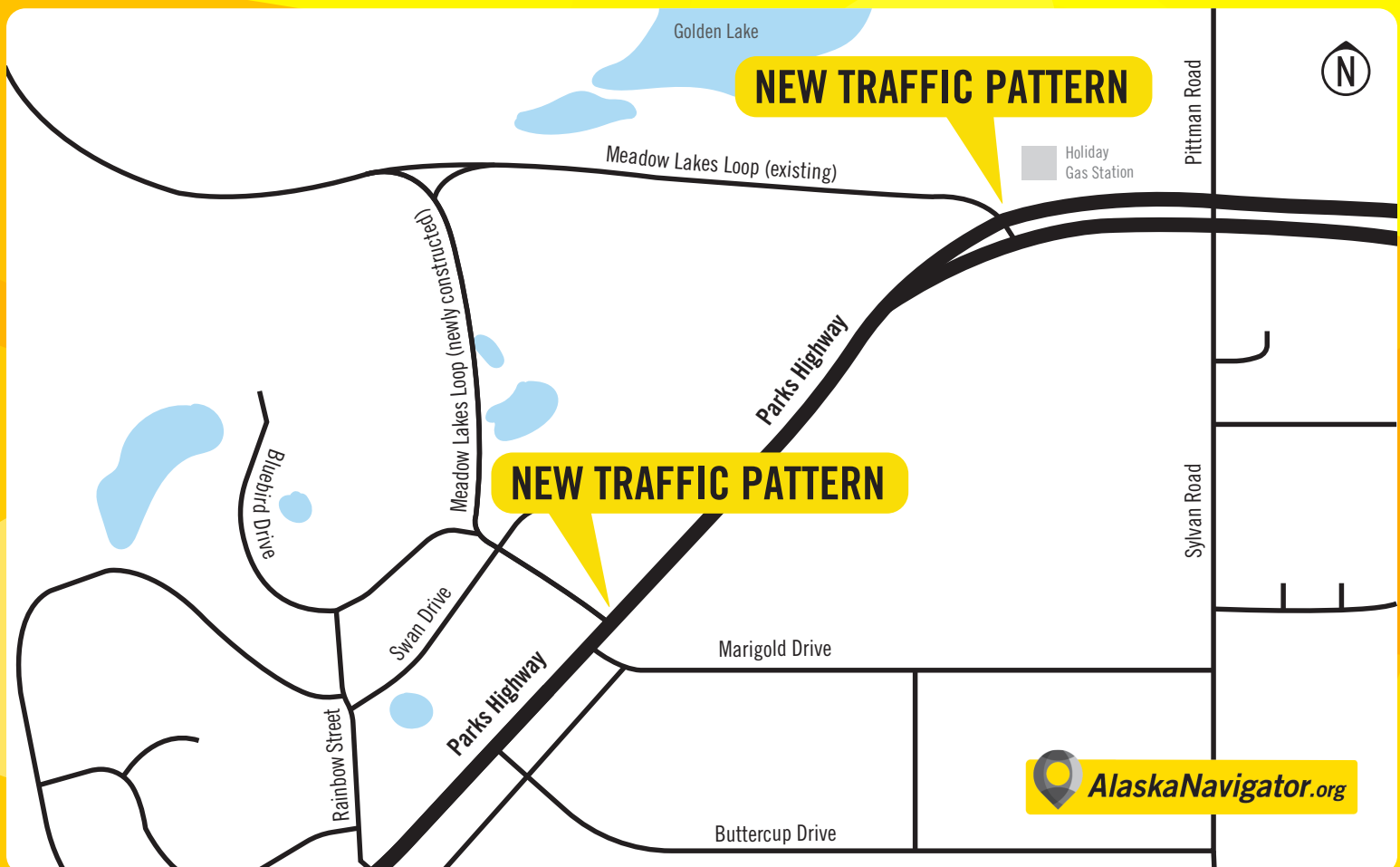

The Alaska Department of Transportation, in cooperation with QAP, is upgrading the existing two-lane highway to a four-lane divided highway. Crews will be installing continuous highway lighting, new signs, and guardrail. There will be signalized intersections at Parks Highway and Meadow Lakes Loop, Parks Highway and Johnson Road, and Parks Highway and Big Lake Road. A multi-use pathway will also be constructed along the entire length of the corridor.

TRAFFIC PATTERN OVERVIEW:

- Beginning Thursday, September 9, the traffic pattern at the existing Meadow Lakes Loop and Parks Highway intersection will change to right turn in and right turn out only.
- Southbound travelers can access the Parks Highway at the newly constructed Meadow Lakes Loop and Parks Highway intersection.
- The southbound lanes of the Parks Highway will be CLOSED. All traffic will be moved over to the northbound lanes in a two-way traffic configuration.
